## RETURNING COUNSELOR FORM



**Why Counsel?** Many of our counselors say they keep coming back to camp because it is a place where they always see God at work. Being a part of camp ministry can bring great joy and make a BIG impact for The Kingdom in just one week! You will grow in your faith and get to be part of an awesome community!

**What would it look like?** Our overnight kid's camps for grades 3-12 are in June and they are Monday - Friday. You could counsel for just 5 days or come to as many camps as you want! Counselors who commit to all of June get paid extra. We also have positions open to be on "summer staff." (More about that later).

**What would I do?** As a counselor your responsibilities would be to guide kids and teens as they have fun and seek the Lord. You would lead small group discussion times after chapel, supervise free time activities, go swimming with the campers, make sure they get to bed, be one of the leaders of a team for the week that competes in games. You would do everything with the kids from worshipping with them, eating with them, and encouraging campers as they learn more about God.

**Is there training?** Yes, counselor training is Friday evening to Saturday evening, May 29-30, which is the best way to prepare. However, if you cannot be on site for training we will work with you to complete it in other ways.

**Will I get paid?** Yes, experienced counselors and college students receive a stipend of \$300 per week and new counselors receive \$200 per week of overnight camp. Each counselor receives \$40 per day of day camp. Also, depending on the situation, we can help with transportation costs. You may also stay and eat for free on site for as long as you are serving at camp.

**The Summer Staff Option:** We are currently looking for summer staff who would commit to 8+ weeks and get paid hourly. Summer staff often counsel each week and have an extra responsibility like media, worship, house keeping, or programing behind the scenes. They have the option to live on site and would help some weekends with guest groups.
